And to one hope she presses with ev'ry grace endued.

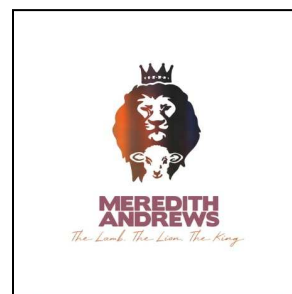
Mid toil and tribulation and tumult of her war,
