and every living thing will join their voice and sing.

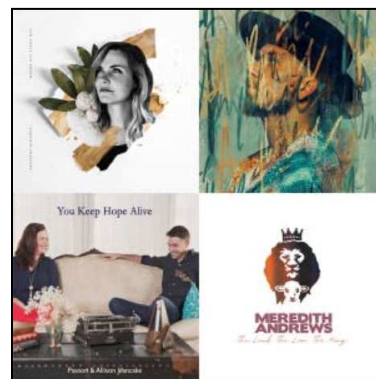
